1. Cabinet Appointed Negotiating Committee of Ministry of Power, on behalf of Ceylon Electricity Board Requests for Proposals from the prospective developers for the deployment of Floating Storage and Regasification Unit (FSRU) with a regasification capacity of 380 MMSCFD and Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) storage capacity of minimum 156,000 m<sup>3</sup> at 100% filling level, at offshore Kerawalapitiya on Build, Own and Operate (BOO) basis and compatible Mooring System on Build, Own, Operate and Transfer (BOOT) basis. The FSRU shall supply regasified LNG for the power plants located in Kerawalapitiya and Colombo area.

The Pipe Line End Manifold (PLEM), subsea pipeline and onshore pipeline up to the boundaries of the power plants will be established by Ceylon Petroleum Corporation on BOOT basis.

2. The project proponent(s) will be required to:
  - Design, finance, procure, construct, deliver, commission, operate and maintain the FSRU.
  - Design, finance, procure, construct, deliver, erect, commission, operate and maintain the Mooring System and transfer to CEB at the end of the term.
  - Secure all environmental clearances, governmental approvals and statutory licenses.
  - Enter into Floating Storage and Regasification Unit & Mooring (FSRU&M) Agreement with Ceylon Electricity Board and the Implementation Agreement with Government of Sri Lanka for the establishment of the above infrastructure. The term of the project is 10 years from the Acceptance under the FSRU&M Agreement.
3. The prospective project proponents shall purchase the Request for Proposal (RFP) Documents at the office of the Project Director (LNG Projects) at the address indicated below between 9:00 Hrs and 15:00 Hrs on working days until two weeks before the proposal submission date and paying a non-refundable fee of LKR 200,000.00 by cash or in the form of bank draft drawn in favor of the General Manager, Ceylon Electricity Board, Colombo, Sri Lanka.
4. If the prospective project proponents wish to receive the RFP documents by post/courier, they shall send a written request to the address given below including a bank draft written in favor of General Manager, Ceylon Electricity Board, to the amount of LKR. 200,000/= (for Domestic delivery) or USD 1,500 (for Overseas Delivery). The RFP documents will be sent through courier/Post and

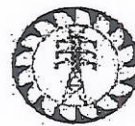

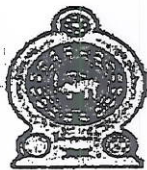

**Invitation for Offers for "Time Chartering" or "Commercial Management" of  
Vessels Owned by Ceylon Shipping Corporation Ltd.  
(Mv. Ceylon Breeze & Mv. Ceylon Princess)**

The Chairman, Standing Cabinet Appointed Procurement Committee (SCAPC) of the Ministry of Ports and Shipping of Sri Lanka, on behalf of Ceylon Shipping Corporation Ltd. (CSC) invites reputed "Charterers" and "Commercial Management Companies" (hereinafter referred to as the "Bidders" also) to submit their bids for "Time Chartering" (IFB No. CSC/2021/T/TC/CB&CP) or "Commercial Management" (IFB No. CSC/2021/T/CM/CB&CP) of one or both ships (Mv. Ceylon Breeze - IMO No. 9734563 and Mv. Ceylon Princess - IMO No. 9734575).

**Conditions:**

1. The vessels will be open with following approx. delivery laycans for deployments (to be narrowed down after selection);
  - a. Mv. Ceylon Princess 07<sup>th</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2021
  - b. Mv. Ceylon Breeze 12<sup>th</sup> - 21<sup>st</sup> April 2021
2. Preferred place of delivery: Puttalam port anchorage / Colombo port outer anchorage, Sri Lanka for both vessels
3. Preferred redelivery ranges: Mv. Ceylon Breeze - East Africa or West Coast of India or Singapore  
Mv. Ceylon Princess - East Coast of India
4. Deployment period for both vessels will be up to around mid-August 2021.
5. Remittances of the charter hires shall be made for 15 days in advance to CSC's nominated bank account/s in United States Dollars direct by the charterers.
6. The selected Bidder/s shall enter into mutually agreed Implementation Agreement/s ("Commercial Management Agreement" or "Charter party Agreement," as applicable). In either case, charter party agreements shall be as per NYPE93 charter party format as amended with Rider Clauses subject to trading and cargo exclusions.
7. SCAPC reserves the right to select the Bids received for the option of "Time Chartering" or "Commercial Management" for one ship or both ships, depending on the net highest economic benefit that will be

accrued to CSC. Therefore, the Bids received for "Time Chartering" and then for "Commercial Management" will be evaluated in that order.

**Eligibility Criteria:**

1. The Bidders should be registered entities in Sri Lanka or any other country and be a member of the Baltic & International Maritime Council (BIMCO) or The Baltic Exchange or any other similar internationally recognized organization acceptable to SCAPC, with an experience of at least three (03) years in chartering and operations of ships / Commercial Management, in the Supramax / Ultramax / Panamax dry bulk categories.
2. Bidders should submit at least 03 Service Letters as References signed by a Director of the client company, as applicable for Time Chartering or Commercial Management ).
